Also he requested to all nodal officers to cooperate with the same. Dr. Indrajit Patel also mentioned colleges like Bhuj, Patan, Valsad, Bharuch, Godhra are about to complete DPR for their villages. He also requested to all nodal officers to look after for overall development of villages as given Gap analysis. All the colleges have finalized their proposals for Physical, Social and Renewable Energy Infrastructure Facilities. With the help of PG students, students of Degree and Diploma can strengthen their work and go for overall recommendation and Suggestions. Sustainable development should be considered for any design for village development.

Dr. Indrajit Patel also mentioned about Orientation Program held in Ahemdabad, Surat, Godhra and Rajkot which was very much helpful for students to have technical knowledge and interaction with Government representatives from villages.

She also shared some issues which was identified by her and given solutions of the same to nodal officers. Live stock management and sustainable planning should be considered for better planning for future. for example Root Zone Technology for sewerage network is the idle solution for villages.



Mr. Satish Brahmbhatt has shared his experiences while working for various village action plan. He also suggested all that location of infrastructure facilities should be such that everyone can use it. Providing infrastructure facilities are not only the solution. Location of Aaganwadi and safety of children should be considered while planning for education facilities. Uniformity should be considered for all design in villages for same structure as per his point of view.

Prof. M.N.Patel appreciated work done by students so far. He also requested to all nodal officers to encourage students for Vishwakarma Yojna and thanked all.

Prof. Iyer shared his view for village development. As an urban planner he said that every village has its own character and identity. One should developed it by using its existing quality. Population growth rate is higher in India so considering the same village development is the best solution for sustainable development. He also presented one brief presentation on Environmental sanitation Institute- Sughad.

Honourable Vice Chancellor appreciate work done by all Institutes and also expressed his view for Village development.
