Teaching Methods

1. Reading Materials - Print form

The students will be provided printed modules of materials prepared by GTU. The Modules are prepared by subject experts and will cover the detailed syllabi, suggested readings of books and titles.

2. Web support

- 1) Minimum passing mark for any subject is 40% and in total minimum 50% including practical component.
- 2) It is necessary to attend minimum 75% contact classes during each semester, without which candidate will not be allowed to appear in the exam.
- 3) If due to any of the reason, candidate could not appear in end semester exam, then he/she can appear in remedial exam conducted during next semester.
