About The Induction Training Programme

Pedagogy is the art of teaching. Pedagogy involves knowledge and skills which are being able to convey in easier ways that students can understand, remember and apply. The pedagogical skills can be classified into classroom management skills, presentation skills and content-related skills.

Any good teacher knows that a class full of out-of-control students is not going to learn much. A teacher's first major focus is to learn about managing behavior in his or her classroom. This set of pedagogical skills involves establishing clear rules and expectations, because students who do not know what is expected of them are more likely to misbehave. Interactive classroom will never have such behavioral problems as all students are involved in the process. A skilled teacher is able to handle behavioral problems with a minimum amount of disruption to the learning environment.

The other major area of pedagogical skills is that of teaching content effectively. A good teacher will present information in ways that actively engage the students in the content part that they are learning and make them passionate learner. Good pedagogy involves not only imparting information, but also providing opportunities to apply that information.
