Principals/Directors of Colleges affiliated to GTU

The UGC has framed regulation on curbing the menace of ragging in higher educational institutions in order to prohibit, prevent and eliminate the scourge of ragging. These regulations are mandatory and all institutions are required to take necessary steps for its implementation including the monitoring mechanism as per provisions in the above regulations and ensure its strict compliance.

As a step further, UGC is launching, a **National University Film Making Competition** to spread the awareness on ragging amongst students. The films may be documentary/fiction films of duration of about 5-10 minutes. The UGC will constitute an Expert committee to select the 3 best films from the entries submitted by the Universities and give an award of Rs.5.00 Lacs, Rs. 3.00 Lacs, Rs.2.00 Lacs respectively for the 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> best films. The selected films would be the property of UGC and would be uploaded on UGC website while giving credit to the film maker.

The institutes can promote its students & faculty to develop films in ragging. GTU, through an internal selection procedure will select the 3 best entries to send to UGC. Institutes may submit their film entries in a pen drive / DVD to Conference department of University before **31**<sup>st</sup> **October**, **2017**.
