Suggested Activities:

Common for all

1. To have a mass recitation of the National Anthem by all students in the institution at 11:00 AM on Tuesday 23rd August which is the terminal day of the fortnight long celebrations.

Choice (at least one activity from the following)

2. Student could paint greeting cards for Jawans posted at the border stations. These could be sent to the nearest or any APO for forwarding to the Jawans.
3. Students may undertake a mass tree plantation drive which could inculcate the idea of sustainable development among the students.
4. Institutions can invite persons who can talk to the students regarding the freedom movement of 1857, and the Independence Struggle. This includes writers, academics and persons from the defence forces (retired or serving). The focus can be on martyrs from that State/UT or local area.

9. Play with freedom movement as theme
