A business concept is a bridge between an idea and execution of the business plan. It focuses one's thinking so that the entrepreneur can identify the specifics of his/her proposed venture. Converting an idea into a business concept requires to produce ideas about how the product or service will be sold and who will buy it, the benefits of the product or service, how it is differentiated from similar ones, and methods of delivery.
